INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

ARCIDE is a liquid cadmium compound, readily soluble in water which can be applied to greens with assurance that cadmium is spread more evenly on grass.

DIRECTIONS:

For the control and prevention of Dollar Spot and Copper Spot: Apply 1 ounce of ARCIDE per 1,000 sq. ft. at ten-day intervals throughout the turf disease season. Amount of water recommended: Dilute ARCIDE with the amount of water called for by the type of sprayer being used. Use sufficient water to assure coverage. (Usually 1 ounce of ARCIDE in 3 to 5 gallons of water is sufficient for coverage.) Clean sprayer thoroughly with water after each use.

KEEP FROM FREEZING

Disposal of Empty Containers and Spillage

- (a) Do not re-use containers. When empty, rinse thoroughly with water. Perforate and bury container.
- (b) Flush spillage with large quantities of water.
