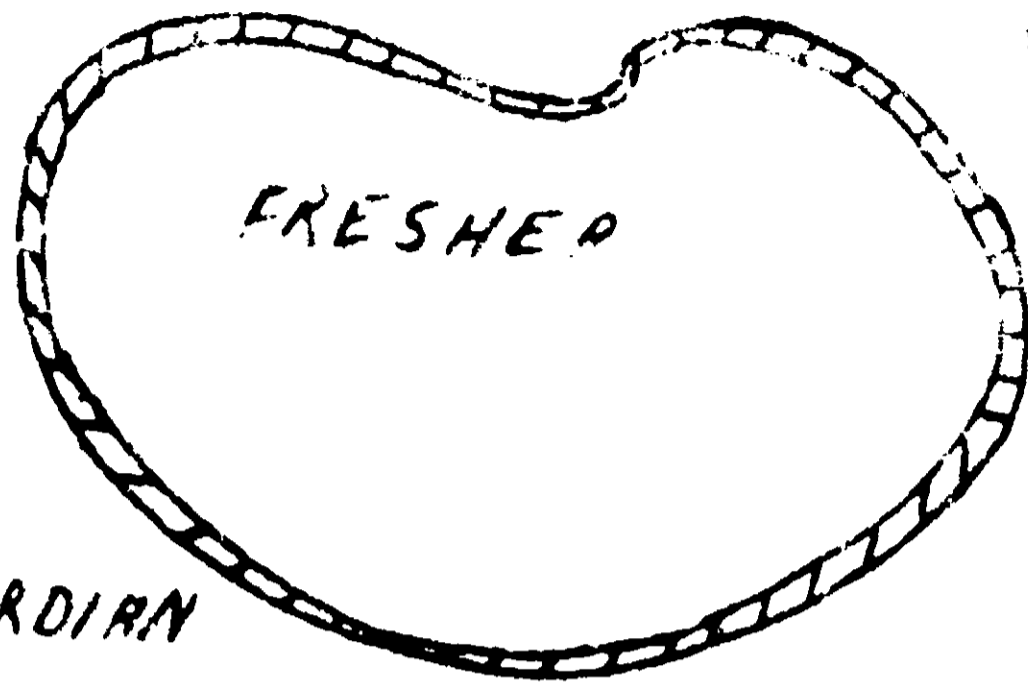

DIRECTIONS:

POOL Water treatment is excellent for algae control. Initial dosage, one quart in 10,000 gallon tank. For maintenance, one cup (8 fluid oz.) per 20,000 gallons. In case of black algae, use Algae Remover.

POOLS: Sanitation of pools is important. Apply as final rinse.

Disinfecting deodorizing solution: After cleaning, pool surface areas apply solution containing one tablespoon Guardian per 2 gallons of water.

K.D. (killing dilution) and P.C. (phenol coefficient) minimum guaranteed 20°C.

PRECAUTIONS: GUARDIAN spilled on unprotected skin should be immediately flushed with water. Avoid contact with skin. In case of such contact, wash thoroughly with water. If contact persists, obtain medical attention. GUARDIAN should not be used in contact with food, and is harmful if swallowed. GUARDIAN is not flammable at the use dilutions. Protect from freezing.
