ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates and may adversely affect non-target plants. Use anytime moss is a problem. Repeat if needed. Rake lawn lightly to remove leaves and dead grass. Mow lawn to expose moss and allow fertilizer to enter soil readily. Apply with spreader at recommended rates. **WATER LAWN IMMEDIATELY AFTER APPLICATION.**

NORMAL MOSS INFESTATIONS

For normal control of moss, apply at the rate of four pounds per 1,000 square feet. A 20 pound bag covers 5,000 square feet.

HEAVY MOSS INFESTATIONS

For heavy infestations of moss, apply at the rate of eight pounds per 1,000 square feet. A 20 pound bag covers 2,500 square feet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this product only in its original container in a dry, cool, secured storage area.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

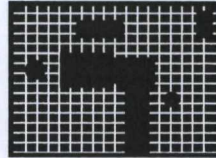
