The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the words "General Classification" and include the "Directions for Use" heading beginning at the top of the left panel.
 - b. Include a 10-minute contact time for the disinfection section.
 - c. The child hazard warning statement must be placed directly above the signal word "DANGER" (center panel only).
- c. Revise the disposal instructions to read:

Pesticide Disposal

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

- e. Revise the referral statement to read "See side panel for additional precautionary statement" (center panel only).
- f.
- g. On the right panel, above the word "DANGER," add the following statement to read:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

- h. Revise the "FIRST AIDS" heading to read "Statement of Practical Treatment."
- i. Delete the word "milk."
- j. Delete the phenol coefficients claims from the label.
- k. Include a 1-minute contact time for the sanitization section. The directions must also provide instructions to drain the use solution from surface and air dry.
- l. Separate the disinfecting and sanitization use directions. Place them under separate headings for clarity.
- m. Under the sanitization use directions, indicate the items to be treated (i.e., dishes, utensils, glassware, etc.).
- n. In the sanitization section, indicate the necessity for removal of glass food particles and soil by a preflush, or prescrape and, when necessary, presoak treatment. In addition, instructions must be provided for a thorough washing of surfaces or objects with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse before application of the sanitizing solution.
- o. Include the method of application (e.g., immersion, flooding, spraying) to wet all surfaces thoroughly.
- p. Please note that potable water rinse is not permitted after the sanitizing rinse and should be deleted from the label.


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

DESCRIPTION:

UNITED 62 is a heavy duty cleaner and disinfectant designed for general purpose use where heavy duty cleaning and sanitizing is of prime importance. When used as directed, UNITED 62 will remove most household dirt and grime in a single, simple application. When used for industrial cleaning follow the use directions shown on the inside panel. Not recommended for *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

For sanitation of food processing equipment or food contact surfaces, the product must be rinsed with potable water.

NOT FOR CONTACT WITH FOOD OR FOOD CONTACT SURFACES. MUST BE RINSED WITH POTABLE WATER PRIOR TO RE-USE.

DANGER:

Keep out of reach of children. Can cause severe eye and skin damage. Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately.
