GENERAL INFORMATION

UL-45 is a ready to use outdoor fogicide for use in mechanical foggers for the control of mosquitos. Both pyrethrins and piperonyl butoxide are non-persistent and break down rapidly in air, soil and water.

UL-45 may be used in mosquito adulticiding programs involving residential, industrial and recreational areas. It is especially effective when used on swamps, overgrown brush, marshes, roadside ditches and pastures, where mosquito infestation presents severe problems.

UL-45 should be applied from evening and early morning, timing applications to coincide with the greatest mosquito activity. Weather conditions should be conducive to allowing the mist to remain close to the ground, and wind should not be greater than 3 miles per hour.

UL-45 may be used with any mechanical type sprayer such as a garden type tank sprayer, a motor driven mist fogger, or a thermal fogger. Apply UL-45 at the rate of 2 to 3 gallons per acre. If sprayer cannot be calibrated to deliver this low volume, dilute UL-45 with an equal amount of kerosene or fuel oil and apply at the rate of 4 to 6 gallons per acre.

Truck Mounted Sprayers: For control of adult mosquitos over a 100 foot swath, use the following flow rates at the indicated truck speeds:

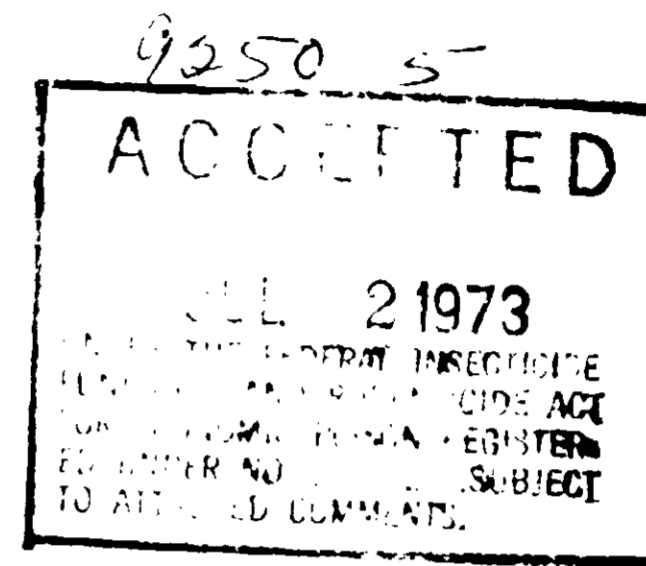
