GENERAL INFORMATION

USES:

1. General weed control in non-crop areas. Controls broadleaf weeds, brush, and grasses. Kills most every type of plant life on contact. It kills through the leaves only.
2. General weed control in shrub areas. Chemical will not injure desirable plants as long as spray does not come in contact with leaves of these plants. Chemical becomes inactive on contact with soil; therefore, plant roots do not take up chemical and chemical does not build up and become toxic at a later date.
3. Spot weed control in lawns and similar areas - will kill undesirable grasses in lawns if these grasses are spot sprayed.
4. General vegetation control around buildings and other installations, walkways, patios, storage areas, beneath greenhouse benches, fence lines, golf courses, sand traps, parkways, driveways, and other areas where any type of vegetation is undesirable.

Note: This product will kill desirable grasses. Therefore, spray only weeds and grasses desired to be killed.

DIRECTIONS

NON-CROP AND NON-PLANTED AREAS: To kill above ground weed growth and buildings and other installations, walkways, patios, storage areas, beneath greenhouse benches, fence lines, golf courses, sand traps, parkways, driveways, in shrubs and lawns, etc., spray with 1.0 to 2.0 lbs. broadleafed and grassy weeds per gallon of water (16 fl. oz. concentrate). Apply for full coverage and thorough wetting of plants. Apply product with wind growth and with wind at your back. Repeat applications necessary to control regrowth. Avoid spray contact with foliage of desirable plants. Do not water the treated area for 24 hours after application.

NOTE:

Rinse spray equipment thoroughly with water after use. Do not apply where drift could injure plants by drift to foliage of other plants that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for consumption.
