"For protection of honey bees avoid use, if possible, during periods when honey bees are visiting the crop. When necessary to use during such periods, warn beekeepers well in advance to locate hives at a safe distance until 1 week after applications".

Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift of spray / dust from areas treated. Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed by punching holes in them and burying with wastes, or by burning (Keep out of smoke).

CAUTION

Keep Out of Reach of Children

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not take internally. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after handling. Clean contaminated clothing daily. Do not contaminate foodstuffs, feed, nesting troughs or receptacles.

DIRECTIONS: Use sufficient amount of dust to obtain full coverage. Apply when insects or their signs appear. Repeat at 5 to 7 day intervals or as necessary for good control. Use in accordance with label directions and cautions. Sevin dust applied up to time of harvest.

COTTON: To control Boll Weevil, Boll Worms, Thrips, Leaf Beetles, Fall Army Worms, dust at rate of 10 to 40 lbs. per acre according to infestation. For Stink Bugs dust at 10 lbs. per acre according to infestation.

BEANS: Mexican Bean Beetle, dust at rate of 10 lbs. per acre according to infestation.

PEANUTS: Velvet Bean Caterpillar (Peanut Worm), the ^{FALL} ~~Red~~ Army Worm and Thrips, apply from 10 to 40 lbs. per acre depending upon size of plant and infestation. Repeat as often as needed.
