## CAUTION

### Keep Out of Reach of Children

## DIRECTIONS

**FOR HARD TO KILL BOLLWEEVIL:** Apply 20-40 lbs. per acre per application. As well as Bollweevil, Malathion kills at 10 to 20 lbs. per acre, Desert



### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Malathion (O, O-Dimethyl dithiophosphate of Diethyl mercaptosuccinate) 5.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS 95.0%

**Spices:** Wheat, Cotton Aphids, Leafhoppers, Cotton Leafworm, Thrips, White Flies, Cotton Leaf Perceps and Bugs - Cotton Leafworm. For Lygus Bug use 10 lbs. per acre.

**TOBACCO:** Apply 10 to 15 lbs. per acre for control of aphids.

**PEANUTS:** For control Mexican Bark Beetle, Leafhopper and aphids, use 25 to 30 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of picking.

**CITRUS, FRUIT, TURKEY, SORGHUM:** For control aphids, leafhoppers, weevils, use 10 to 15 lbs. per acre. Do not apply to citrus, turkey or sorghum within 6 days of picking. Do not apply to citrus within 1 day of picking.

**WATERMELON, CUCUMBER:** Apply 10 to 15 lbs. per acre. Do not apply to watermelon or cucumber within 1 day of picking.

**CUCUMBER, SQUASH AND MELON:** Apply 10 to 15 lbs. per acre. Do not apply to cucumber, squash or melon within 1 day of picking.

**GRAPES:** Apply 10 to 15 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of picking.
