The amendment referred above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the label changes listed below before you release the product for shipment.
 - a. Delete the claim for "safety and snorkel equipment. Adequate descriptions must be provided for this claim. You must also indicate how this claim is food related.
 - b. Under "Directions For Use", item #1, revise and expand the directions to read: "The necessity for removal of gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment". You must provide instructions for thoroughly washing the surfaces or objects with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse prior to application of the sanitizing solution. Refer to DIS/TSS-17 enclosure, item #3.
 - c. The proposed label must be expanded to include the directions as specified in item #7 of DIS/TSS-17 enclosure.
 - d. The label must be expanded to include the major areas of use as specified in DIS/TSS-17 enclosure, item #1.

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
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When preparing sanitizing solution, allow several minutes for tablets to dissolve in water. Stir and before using.

1. Strain and prewash equipment when appropriate.
 2. Prewash equipment with a detergent or compatible cleanser.
 3. Rinse with clean water to remove dirt completely.
 4. Dissolve in a solution of 1 TABLET PER GALLON OF WATER (not ppm) AND DISINFECT ALL EQUIPMENT for at least two minutes or for contact time specifically governing sanitizing table.
 5. Place sanitized equipment on a clean surface to dry.
- Tablet sanitizing solution of 500 ppm concentration may be safely used on food processing equipment and utensils and on other food contact surfaces as specified under Subpart F of the Food Additive Amendment of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.

DISPOSAL
