Delete the use sites "knife sheath" and "smooth skin wet suit." These are considered non-food contact items. Your product is approved for use on food contact surfaces only. In order for you to add non-food contact contact surfaces items, you must submit supporting data in accordance with DIS/TSS -10 enclosure.

Revise the referral statement to read: See left panel for additional precautionary statements.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

When preparing sanitizing solution, allow several minutes for tablet to dissolve in water. STIR WELL BEFORE USING.

For sanitizing Fillet Knife, ~~Measuring~~ Spear Heads, Lobster Measuring Device, Regulator Mouth Piece, Smooth Skin Wet Suit, and Dishes, Glasses and Utensils in Restaurants, Taverns.

1. The necessity for removal of gross food particles and soil by a pre-rinse or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment.

2. Swirl in a solution of 1 TABLET PER GALLON OF WATER (200 PPM) in a clean tank, immerse all gear for at least two minutes or contact time specified by Subpart F of the Feed Additives Amendment of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act.

3. Place sanitized gear on rack or drainboard to dry.

4. For mechanical operations, the limitation that the prepared use solution may not be reused for sanitizing.

5. For manual operations the recommendation that fresh sanitizing solution should be prepared at least daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

DISPOSAL

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard. ALWAYS FOLLOW YOUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT REGULATIONS W. 11-572.
