The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comment listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Five (5) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted before you release the product for shipment.

Revise the referral statement to read "See left panel for additional precautionary statements."

The submitted sanitizing data (for non-food contact surfaces) developed by the AOAC Official Methods of Analysis (15th edition 1990) supports the proposed claim as a non-food contact surface sanitizer versus Enterobacter aerogenes and Staphylococcus aureus at a dilution of 200 ppm (one tablet/gallon of water) when used on specified precleaned hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces which are wetted and allowed to remain wet for a contact time of at least 2 minutes.

This product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 500 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃ when tested by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizers - Official Method.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

DANGER

Keep out of the reach of children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. When preparing sanitizing solution, allow several minutes to dissolve in water. STIR WELL BEFORE USING.

For sanitizing FILLET KNIFE, SPEAR HEADS, LOAF SLICER, DEVICE, REGULATOR MOUTH PICKLE, Dishes, Glasses, etc. in Restaurants, Taverns.

1. The necessity for removal of gross food particles should be pre-rinse or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-wash.
2. Sanitize in a solution of 1 TABLET PER GALLON OF WATER (PPM) in a clean tank. Immerse all gear for at least the contact time specified by Subpart F of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
3. Place sanitized gear on rack or drainboard to drain.
4. For mechanical operations, the limitation of the solution may not be reused for sanitizing.
5. For manual operations the recommendation of the solution should be prepared at least daily or when the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

DISPOSAL

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard. ALWAYS FOLLOW YOUR HEALTH REGULATIONS W-11-F-72.
