NOTE: Treated food contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

This product fulfills the criteria of appendix F of the Grade "A" pasteurized milk ordinance 1965 recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Services.

DIRECTIONS:

The strength of chlorine type bactericides and disinfectants is dissipated by contact with organic substances or soil. Therefore, all equipment and utensils should be thoroughly cleaned before sanitizing.

To Sanitize Equipment*

Immerse or circulate solution of 1/2 oz. (level scoop) in 3 gallons of water; this solution supplies 100 ppm available chlorine.

In all cases, allow solution to remain in contact for at least two minutes.

To Disinfect Equipment:

Preclean surfaces, apply solution of 1/2 oz. (level scoop) per gallon of water. Follow with a potable rinse prior to use of equipment.
