DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Clean and rinse all equipment prior to disinfecting.
2. When used as a bactericide for dairy utensils, milking machines and equipment, use 1½ ounces per 3½ gallons of water. Test frequently to maintain a concentration above 50 ppm. This solution can also be used for washing cows' udders.
3. When used as a disinfectant for equipment in food and beverage plants, use a solution of 1 pound per 40 gallons of water and apply in such a manner that all parts and surfaces are properly reached with solution.
4. For domestic and household, use a solution of 1 ounce per gallon of water for disinfecting glasses, dishes, etc. For cleaning and deodorizing of porcelain and enameled surfaces such as sinks, refrigerators, etc., use a solution of 1 ounce per quart of water.

Caution:

Avoid contact with face or eyes. In case of contact, flush face or eyes with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. If swallowed, call a physician.

500	2
1000	4
