DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Measure needed amount into bucket of water, stir to make thin sturry. Add to tank when part full, and before other materials are added. Add wetting agents last to avoid foaming.

APPLES, PEARS: Powdery Mildew, Scab, Blister Mites, Silver Mites, Red Spider spp. 2-6 pounds per 100 gals, water, Do not apply to D'anjou Pears. Apply pre bloom and petal fall. Apply with cover sprays throughout the season.

ALMONDS, CHERRIES, PLUMS, PRUNES: Brown Rot, Powdery Mildew, Leaf Spot, Silver Mites, Flat Mites, Red Spider spp. 2-6 pounds per 100 gals, of water. Apply at bloom or early petal fall, repeat as necessary, usually 10-14 days, or after a period of wet weather.

PEACHES, NECTARINES: Brown Rat, Powdery Mildew, Silver Mites, Red Spider spp. 2-6 pounds per 100 gals, water. Apply at bloom or early petal fall, repeat as necessary, usually 10-14 days, or after a period of wet weather.

CITRUS: Flat Mite, Silver Mites, Red Spider spp. 2-6 pounds per 100 gals, of water, Apply in any spray during season — NOT CONTAINING OIL or following oil by 14 days | | | | |

GRAPES: Powdery Mildew, Bud Mite, Blister Mite, Red Spider spp. 2 to 6 pounds per 100 gals. of water. Apply in late dormant, or with cutworm spray, early shoot period and thru season on 14 day schedule, or with posticides.

POTATOES:

BEANS, PEAS, COLE CROPS, PEPPERS, Powdery Mildew, Red Spider spp. 3-5 pounds per acre in 15-50 gals, of water by aircroft or ground rig. Start in early leaf stage. Repeat application every 10-14 days with or without pesticides, or immediately after a rain.

COTTON, SEED ALFALFA: Red Spider spp. Apply 3-5 pounds per acre in 25-50 gallons of water by air craft or ground rig.

STRAWBERRIES: Powdery Mildew, Red spider spp. 3-5 pounds per 100 gals, of water. Start in early leaf stage: repegt applications with or without pesticides.

TOMATOES: Russet Mite, Apply 3-5 pounds per acre. Thorough coverage is required, 25 to 50 gallons of water either by air or ground rig.

OLIVES: Bud Mites, apply 2 lbs. per 100 gallons of water.

PEACHES, NECTARINES: Brown Rot, Powdery Mildew, Silver Mites, Red Spider, apply 2-6 lbs. per 100 gallons water. Apply at bloom or early petal fall, repeat as necessary, usually 10-14 days, or after a period of wet weather.

STRAWBERRIES: Powdery Mildew, Red Spider, apply 3-5 lbs. per 100 gallons of water. Start in early leaf stage; repeat applications with or without pesticides.

TOMATOES: Russet Mite, apply 3-5 lbs. per acre. Thorough coverage is required, 1.5 to 50 gallons of water either by air or ground rig.

BLACKBERRY: (Rubis Spp): Red Berry Mites (Eriophytes Gracilis) apply 3-5 lbs, per 100 gals, water. Start in early bud swell, repeat applications as necessary, with or without pesticides.

RASPBERRY (Rubis Spp): Powdery Mildew (Sphaerotheca Humuli) spray each week, starting at first bloom-color with 3-5 lbs. per 100 gals. of water. Continue until all fruit is set, then repeat as weather requires.

SUGAR BEETS: Red Spider Spp. apply 3-5 lbs. per acre in 15-50 gal, water, by aircraft or ground rig. Apply as needed with ar without pesticides.

HOPS: Red Spider (spp) apply 2-6 lbs. per 100 gals, water. Start in early leaf stage, repeat applications as needed, usually 10-14 days.

LERF SPOT:

PEANUTS: Powdery Mildew, Red Spider Mite, Apply 3 to 5 lbs. per acre in 15 to 50 gallons of water by aircraft or ground rig. Start in early leaf stage. Repeat applications as necessary, usually 10 to 14 days.
