

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin and eye contact. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Apply as a surface spray only. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash and rinse with potable water dishes and food handling utensils contaminated with this product. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wild life. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or by disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame. Keep container sealed when not in use. Isolate leaking containers. Recover spilled product by mechanical means or by use of a clay type oil absorbent. Clean area with a suitable detergent solution and rinse. Recover waste cleaning solution and rinsate.

ROSE 202 is a residual insecticide for indoor spot applications as a surface spray. Use in spot treatments around window sills, door sills, baseboards, under sinks, pipes, cupboards, and in animal sleeping quarters, crawl spaces, and elsewhere listed areas for control of such crawling pests as cockroaches, ants, spiders, silverfish, crickets, carpet beetles, and Brown Dog ticks. Refer to instructions elsewhere on label for specific pest control in given areas.

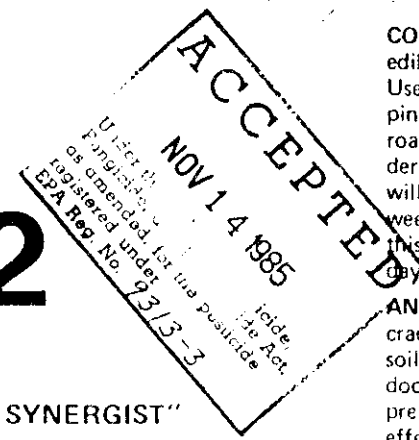

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING:** vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material is taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
