WHEN TO APPLY: Annual Weeds and Grasses - It is best to apply in the spring or when weeds are small.

Perennial Weeds and Grasses - In areas of light rainfall (less than 20 inches), it is generally better to apply in fall and winter months. In areas with heavy winter rains, spring applications usually give best results.

General Note: Avoid application in hot dry weather as moisture is required to activate the chemical. By preventing weed growth early in the year, fire hazard from dead and dry vegetation are avoided later.

CAUTIONS

In Applications: Do not apply on or near turf, valuable trees or other plants, or in areas into which their roots may extend. The chemical should be used only where unproductive soil is not objectionable. Avoid contamination of irrigation water.

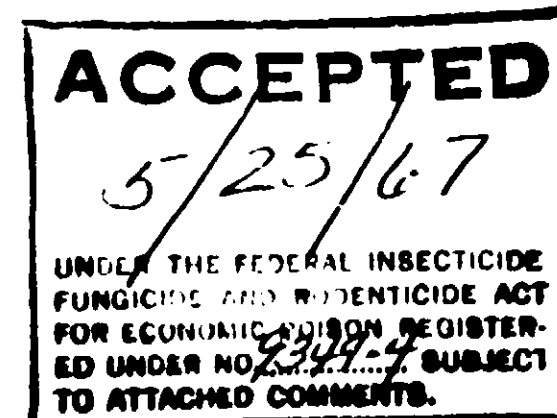

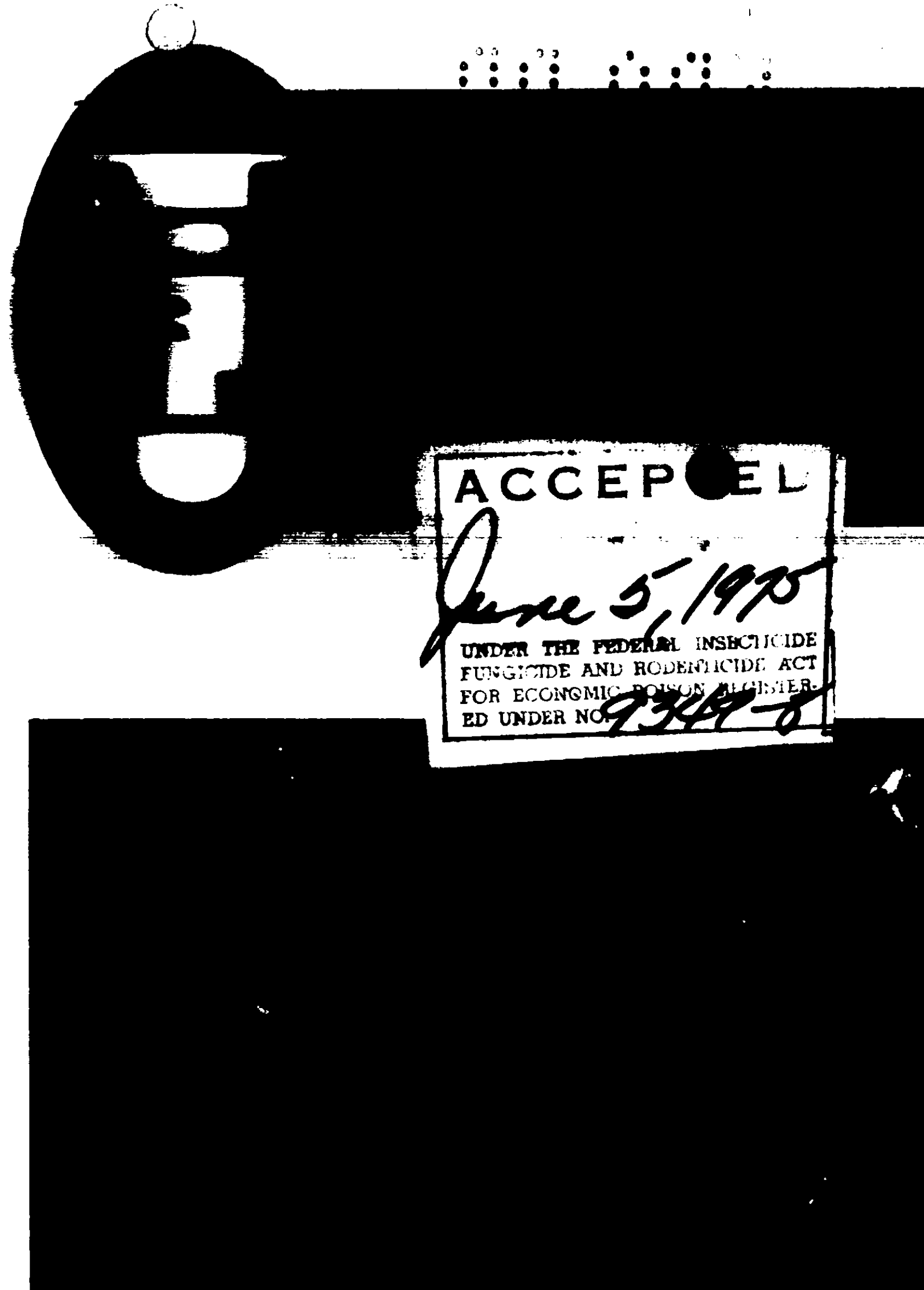

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Uniformly spray one gallon of RAVAGE NON-SELECTIVE VEGETATION KILLER mixed in ten gallons of water over 1,000 sq. ft. of soil surface. Thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or soon after weed emergence while growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 1½ gallons of RAVAGE NON-SELECTIVE VEGETATION KILLER in ten gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnsongrass, Bindweed, and Wild Carrot, use 3-4½ gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. Although RAVAGE NON-SELECTIVE VEGETATION KILLER has considerable activity through foliage contact, much of its activity is through the roots and therefore, adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary. Repeat if necessary.

Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free surface.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees, or woody ornamental plants. Only apply herbicide outside of the drip line of trees. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

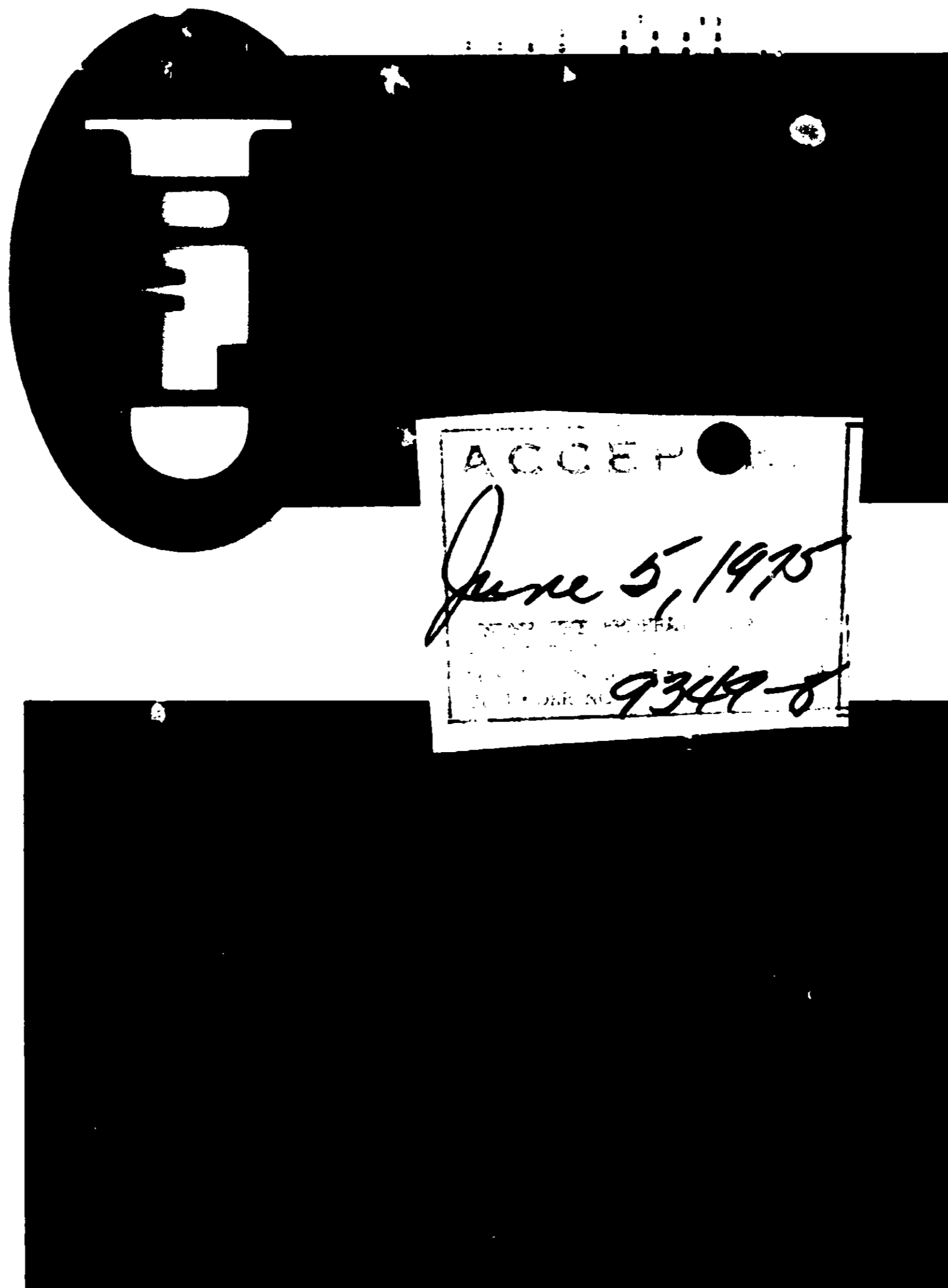
