

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a

ALGAECEIDE NF-6

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, use ALGAECEIDE NF-6 in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae. To use, add ALGAECEIDE NF-6

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of established algae growth remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of established algae growth add initially 69 to 97 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae require an initial dose of 10 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 1000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 should be made 7 to 10 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

ALGAECEIDE NF-6

Use ALGAECEIDE NF-6 in the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. Pools should be treated during the swimming season and are not to be treated during the off-season. Add 110 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 10,000 gallons of water. Season pools have some visible algae growth, add 110 fluid ounces of ALGAECEIDE NF-6 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. Repeat the treatment one or more times if necessary.

ALGAECEIDE NF-6

ALGAECEIDE NF-6 is used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. ALGAECEIDE NF-6 can be used with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix ALGAECEIDE NF-6 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking container should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
