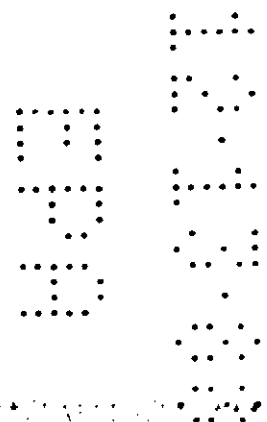

- g. Revise the statement:

. . . It will kill and prevent the development of Chlorella . . .

to read:

. . . It will control the growth of Chlorella

- h. The correct nomenclature for Phormidium inundatum and Phormidium retzii are "Blue-green algae." Revise accordingly.

- i. Delete reference to "aquatic invertebrates."

Note: Inadequate data supports this claim in the Stepan file.

- j. Delete the statement:

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Note: Your data indicates that this statement is not warranted.

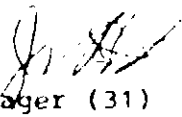
- k. Revise Co. to read Company in the address section of the label.
