**INITIAL APPLICATION
FOR SWIMMING POOLS**

(To A Clean Pool)

4 gallons to each 50,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof. If Algae growth is visible apply the initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.

CONTINUED APPLICATION

4 quarts in 50,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Ox ternary Test Kits are available for this use.

BOOSTER APPLICATION

4 quarts in 50,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load.

The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use.

If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose.
