 - a. For consistency, revise the Total percentage to read: 100.00%
 - b. The Inert Ingredient percentage should read: 97.50% not 97.5%
 - c. Delete the phrase: General Classification.
 - d. The misuse statement: "It is a violation of Federal law..." must be placed directly below the heading: Directions for Use.
 - e. Delete the statement: When properly stored for prolonged periods of time, will not lose its effectiveness or strength.
2. A release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
3. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

However note for future reference that the upper certified limit (Block 14a) should be around 2.6% and the lower certified limit (Block 14b) should be around 2.4% for this product.

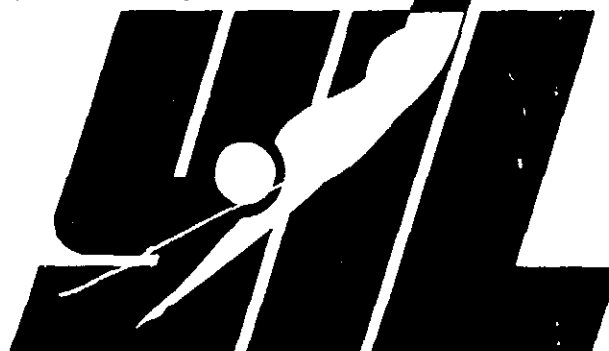

**INITIAL APPLICATION
FOR SWIMMING POOLS**

(For A Clean Pool)

4 gallons to each 50,000 gallons of water or ratio thereof. If Algae growth is visible apply the initial dose. Vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If algae is still visible repeat dose as necessary until pool is free of visible algae.

CONTINUED APPLICATION

4 quarts in 50,000 gallons of water every 3-5 days or as needed to maintain 2 ppm active. Quaternary Test Kits are available for this use.

BOOSTER APPLICATION

4 quarts in 50,000 gallons after a heavy or prolonged rainfall or when there is a heavy bathing load.

The above directions should be followed even when the pool is not in use.

If algae growth is noticeable, apply the initial dose.

Compatible with many swimming pool chemicals and when used as directed it is not harmful to the metal paint, plastic or tile surfaces of the swimming pool.

When used as directed, will help improve the appearance and cleanliness of the swimming pool water.
