DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT USE ON ANY SURFACES OTHER THAN TOILETS AND URINALS, EXCEPT AS DIRECTED.

TO CLEAN, DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS: Remove water from bowl with mop or by forcing water over trap. Squeeze water from mop and place mop in bowl. Saturate mop with cleaner and swab bowl all over, especially under rim at water outlets. Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes. Flush and rinse mop.

TO CLEAN, DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE URINALS: Hold mop over trap and saturate with cleaner. Swab all surfaces including water outlets at top and grooves. Remove screen and pour 3 to 5 ounces of cleaner in drain. Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes. Swab drain and replace screen. Flush and rinse mop.

TO DISINFECT ONLY: Pour 10 ounces of cleaner into bowl water. Swab commode seat and cover with solution. Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes. Flush toilet and rinse mop several times. Then rinse seat thoroughly and wipe dry. Inhibited to prevent damage to pipes and drains.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE - Store in a dry place no lower in temperature than 50°F or higher than 120°F.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL - Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. DANGER

FIRST AID

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms.
