DIRECTIONS

GENERAL DISINFECTANT: Remove all filth and dirt from surfaces such as floors, walls, woodwork, desks to be disinfected and then mop them with a solution of 1 part disinfectant in 100 parts of water (1-1 3 oz. per gallon). If used on surfaces in contact with food, rinse with potable water.

TOILET BOWLS, URINALS, BEDPANS, CUSPIDORS: Remove water from bowl with mop, or by forcing water over the trap. Clean thoroughly, then disinfect, using a solution of 3 oz. disinfectant to 1 gallon of water (1 to 43 dilution). Let some of this solution remain in cuspidors at all times.

DISINFECTION OF PSEUDOMONAS AERUGINOSA: Mop cleaned surfaces with a solution of 1 part disinfectant in 64 parts of water (2 oz. per gallon).

KENNELS: Clean thoroughly, then spray or mop with a solution of 2 oz. pine odor disinfectant to a gallon of water (1 to 64 dilution).

GARBAGE TRUCKS - To degrease and deodorize garbage trucks, dilute 1 part of pine odor disinfectant with 4 parts of naphtha and spray soiled surfaces thoroughly. Let soak for 5 minutes. Rinse with clean water.

DANGER

Keep out of reach of children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and severe skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid prolonged breathing of spray mist. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
