**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove all heavy soil and gross filth before disinfection.

**HARD SURFACE DISINFECTION**

On previously cleaned, hard surfaces, add 6 ounces to 1 gallon of water. Apply solution with a mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes, then remove excess liquid. A fresh solution should be prepared for each use. This product has been proven effective against Salmonella choleraesuis by the ADAC use-dilution test.

**TO DISINFECT TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS**

Flush toilet or urinal and add 8 ounces directly to bowl or urinal water. Swab all surfaces completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim and around water outlets. Let stand 10 minutes and flush.

**AS A GENERAL CLEANER**

Add 2 to 3 ounces to 1 gallon of water. Apply solution to surface using a mop, cloth, or sponge. Let stand a few minutes then rinse with clear water.
