**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION:

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes, or clothing should also be avoided. Wear protective gloves when making applications. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas.

Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children.

Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Remove pets, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until they are dry.

STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of poisoning, call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

IF ON SKIN: Wash immediately with soap and warm water. If irritation occurs, get medical attention. **IF EYES ARE CONTAMINATED:** Wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention. **IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause an aspiration hazard.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: A sense of "tightness" in chest. Sweating. Contracted pupils. Stomach pains. Vomiting and diarrhea.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

ANTIDOTE: Administer atropine sulfate in therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of tolerance.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nervous. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Do not cut container with torch as explosive may result.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide waste are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these waste cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state pesticide or environmental control agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

Container disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If contain is leaking invent to prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or causes, carefully dam spilled material to prevent runoff. Refer to precautionary statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Absorb spilled material with absorbing type compounds and dispose of as directed for pesticides above. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.
