**GENERAL DIRECTIONS:** Unicide Concentrate should be diluted by adding to one gallon of Concentrate, giving a total of 10 gallons of finished ready-to-use spray. The finished spray, after dilution, should be applied as a fine mist, in the control of FLYING INSECTS, to and fill the air with mist, using 2 or 3 ounces of concentrate per gallon before spraying. To control CRAWLING AND CRAWLING INSECT PESTS, (as listed above), treat all areas where these insects are commonly found, and direct a coarse spray toward drains and dark corners — spray when possible.

**CARPET BEETLES:** Treatment should include spraying of floors, carpets and cracks around baseboards.

**SILVERFISH, SPIDERS and CLOTHES MOTHS:** Treatment should include spraying of the clothing in closets, and interiors.

**CLOVER MITES:** Follow general directions for crawling insects. A special effort should be made to spray directly on Clover Mites whenever possible, however.

**BEDBUGS:** Repeat spraying of mattresses, beds, springs, and baseboards. Bedbugs have best results in getting rid of Bedbugs. After Bedbugs are killed, a regular spray schedule should be begun to prevent new infestation.

**FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS:** Pay particular attention to floor areas, cracks, and crevices. Thoroughly spray floor covering.

**ANTS AND ROACHES:** Follow general direction for crawling insects. Be particularly careful to treat ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where pests enter the premises.

**NOTE:** Areas where insects enter homes, such as around windows and doors, should always be sprayed to aid in controlling all types of infestations.
