FEEDING INSTRUCTIONS

RANCH-O Bar-Fly Blocks are to be fed as a dietary supplement. Do not feed any other salt. Allow one block for each ten (10) head of cattle. The blocks should be distributed over a large area to allow livestock good access to blocks. Locate the supplement near the animals' water or near their feeding area. RANCH-O Bar-Fly Blocks eaten at the rate of 3/4 ounces daily per 100 lbs. of body weight will supply the minimum amount of phenothiazine necessary to aid in the control of the breeding of face flies and horn flies and to aid in the control of certain gastrointestinal parasites such as common stomach worms, nodular worms and hookworms of cattle.

For maximum protection against horn flies, cattle should be sprayed at the start of the fly season and fed RANCH-O Bar-Fly continuously, beginning several weeks before the fly season, until all adult horn flies have disappeared in the fall. RANCH-O Bar-Fly prevents the breeding of horn flies and face flies in the manner of treated cattle but does not affect any existing adult flies. "Since face flies migrate from farm to farm it is essential that the serviceable program be carried out on an area basis to assist in reduction of the adult face fly population."

Consult your veterinarian for assistance in the diagnosis, treatment, and control of parasitism.
