**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Feed RANCH-O PHOS-8 at the rate of 3 ounces per head per day free choice or by mixing it into the grain. RANCH-O PHOS-8 may be fed up to slaughter weight. Begin feeding RANCH-O PHOS-8 early in the spring and continue feeding throughout the summer into the fall until the flies are gone.

RANCH-O PHOS-8 prevents the development of stable flies in the manure of treated cattle but is not a fly repellent. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, take measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some cases, supplemental fly control measures may be necessary in barns and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies in manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage.
