

AMA-35D-P
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Laboratory testing has shown AMA-35D-P effective against the following bacteria at the ppm indicated:

<u>BACTERIA</u>	<u>PPM</u>
<u>Bacillus cereus</u>	100 - 110
<u>Pseudomonas fluorescens</u>	80 - 90
<u>Desulfovibrio desulfuricans</u>	5 - 10

HANDLING PROCEDURES

STABILITY : Avoid contact with strong acids; CS_2 and/or H_2S may be formed. Hazardous polymerization will not occur.

SOLUTIONS: Add 86 lbs. of 50% caustic to 20 gallons of water. Make sure that the temperature does not go above 80°F or below 70°F. Then add AMA-35D-P (100 lbs) slowly with stirring.

NOTE : TEMPERATURE CONTROL IS IMPORTANT WHEN ADDING AMA-35D-P.
