Dogs and Cats: To kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks, apply a light coating sufficient to wet the fur taking care not to get product in animal's eyes, hub the wipe sufficiently around head, ears, chest and nose. Then apply as needed to the neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best results, and

pentration apply treatment using the wipe against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired animals repeat the treatment as necessary to insure the hair is thoroughly saturated

Puppies and Kittens: Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens, apply a light coating along animal's back and rub into animal's fur.

Pet Sleeping Quarters: Wipe around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If Mosquitoes, Gnats or Flies are present. Repeat as needed. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended.

Horses: To repel Gnats, Flies and Mosquitoes, apply a light coating sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. To control Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies and Face Flies, apply as needed sufficient to wet the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment as needed.

Storage: Do not store or use near heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in newspaper and put in trash.
