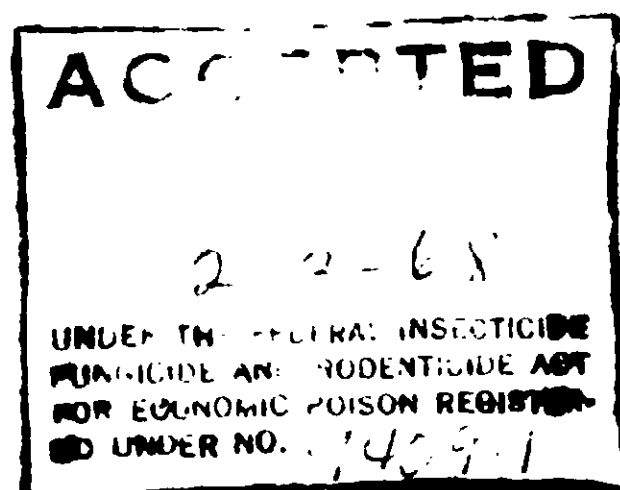

TABLE OF DILUTIONS

2oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 1 Gal. Water: 2600 ppm Chlorine
1oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 1 Gal. Water: 1300 ppm Chlorine
1oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 2 Gal. Water: 650 ppm Chlorine
1oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 4 Gal. Water: 325 ppm Chlorine
1oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 15 Gal. Water: 99 ppm Chlorine

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

As Sanitizer for food handling equipment, food containers, etc. - scrub and rinse to remove blood, fat and gross soil. Use 1oz. H.D. Sanitizer to 15 gallon water. Let stand on equipment for several minutes. Drain. Rinse thoroughly.

As Sanitizer for walls, floors, etc. - scrub and rinse to remove blood, fat and gross soil. Use higher concentrations of H.D. Sanitizer as desired. Let stand several minutes. Rinse thoroughly.

As Germicide - scrub and rinse as above. Use 1 oz. or more of H.D. Sanitizer to 2 gallon water. Let stand several minutes. Rinse thoroughly.
