STATEMENTS OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: This product contains an organic phosphate which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. If symptoms of parasympathetic stimulation are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Poisoning may occur as a result of exposure. Wear rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash hands thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Food utensils such as teaspoons or measuring cups should not be used for food purposes after use with insecticide. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Sunniland FLOWER POWER is a fertilizer containing primary and certain other essential plant food elements, combined with a systemic insecticide to control sucking insects. This insecticide is absorbed through the roots of the plants along with the food and protects the plant from within. It cannot be washed off and will protect new shoots as well as undersides of leaves. Do not use product around fruit trees or vegetable plants. Do not broadcast application on lawns.

WHEN TO APPLY

Start a regular program of fertilization as needed and continue at six week intervals. When used a directed, this material will furnish adequate plant food and protect plants from sucking insects for six weeks or longer.

HOW TO USE

ROSES: On established roses, spread 1/3 cup (2 ounces) evenly around the base of each plant and work into the top 1 to 2 inches of soil. Water thoroughly. Wear rubber gloves and avoid contact with hands. When planting new roses, place 1/4 cup in planting hole and mix with prepared soil. Apply 1/4 cup around plant when hole is filled, working into the top 2 inches. Water well. Additional fertilizer will not be needed for six weeks.

ANNUALS (Petunias, Snapdragons, Calendulas, Marigolds, Zinnias, etc.), **BULB, FLOWER BEDS:** Apply 2 to 3 pounds per each 100 square feet of area. Work into top 1 to 2 inches of soil. Plant seeds or set plants and water thoroughly. For individual plants use 1 teaspoonful around each plant and water well.

POTTED PLANTS: Use one level teaspoonful per 6 inch pot and scratch into the top soil. Water well after application.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS: Apply 2/3 cupful (4 oz.) for each foot of shrub height. Distribute the required amount evenly from the base of the plant to the drip line all around the plant. Work into the top 1 to 2 inches of soil and water thoroughly.

CONVERSION TABLE: 5 rounded table-spoonfuls are equal to 1/3 cup or 2 ounces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, feed, or food by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Store in a cool dry place, preferably in a locked storage areas.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Discard container in trash.
