**DIRECTIONS FOR ORNAMENTAL DISEASES**

Roses, Iris, Dahlia, Pansy, Zinnia, Carnation, Lily, Snapdragon, Holly, Honeysuckle, Chrysanthemum and Gladiolus, for control of Black Spot, Leaf Spot, Botrytis Blight, Anthracnose, Leaf Blight, Rust, Purple Spot and Herpobasidium Blight, use FORE at 1½ lbs. per 100 gallons (1½ level tablespoons per gallon) in full coverage spray. Begin spraying when plants are well leafed-out and apply at 7 to 10 day intervals throughout the season or follow State Extension Service Recommendations.

Azaleas, Camellias, Rhododendron, for control of Petal Blight, spray 2 to 3 times a week while flowers are opening. Direct spray into flowers and spray ground under bushes thoroughly.

**Directions for Ornamental Turf Diseases**

To control Dollar Spot, Fusarium Blight, Slime Mold, Copper Spot, Helminthosporium, Rhizoctonia (Brown Patch), Rust and Algae\*. Use 4-6 ounces per 1000 sq. ft. in sufficient water to provide adequate coverage, usually 10-15 gallons. Repeat every 7-14 days while disease is prevalent. Begin applications before diseases appear.

\*Apply spray when Algae are first visible.
