The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

- 1) Revise "Maximum of two applications per" to "Maximum of two applications per year" in the statement prior to the Environmental Hazards section.
- 2) Revise the subsection heading "General Precautions and Restrictions for Best Results" to "Use Restrictions"
- 3) Move the statement "Weeder Feeder must be watered into the turf immediately after application for safety, best weed control and fertilizer benefit" from the Use Restrictions section to the Use Precautions section below.

Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

Apply Sunniland Weeder Feeder at the rate of 25 lbs. per 5,000 sq.ft. Water in after application. A second application in the same year, to the same area, at the same rate, will give longer weed control and required turfgrass response to the fertilizer.

WHEN TO APPLY

For best results apply before weeds come up. Established weeds are more difficult to control and may require an application in the spring and in the fall. Usually application made between January 1 and March 1 give best weed control; but applications may be made through June.
