STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water  
and induce vomiting by touching back of throat  
with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give  
anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
Get medical attention.

IF INHALED - Keep patient strictly at rest and  
transfer to hospital immediately to get medical  
attention.

IF ON SKIN - Wash with soap and warm water.

IF IN EYES - Rinse thoroughly with clean water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains Anticholinesterase  
Carbamate Insecticide. In cases of overexposure  
Atropine Sul fate - 2 mg. (equivalent to 1/30 grain  
adult dose) should be given and repeated as  
necessary until fully atropinized
