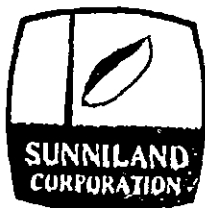

For best results thoroughly treat when lawn is moist. Apply when pests first appear or their damage is eminent & repeat as needed for control. Chinch Bug control will last up to 8 weeks therefore apply as soon as temperatures reach 80°F and repeat every 2 months through the season.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until the spray has dried.

 Ornamental plants refer to chart for mixing and thoroughly spray infested ornamental plants to point just before spray "run-off". Apply when pests are first seen or their damage is imminent then repeat for control or at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. Use an appropriate hand held or power sprayer to give complete and uniform spray coverage.

DO NOT USE ON AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS, POINSETTIAS, ROSE BUSHES OR VARIEGATED IVY BECAUSE OF POSSIBLE SPRAY INJURY TO THESE PLANTS.

**IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT**

As an aid in the control of the Imported Fire Ant in lawns, flower gardens and around the home mix 3 1/2 fluid ounce per gallon of water. Gently sprinkle 1 gallon on the center of the mound. Apply in cool weather or in early morning or late afternoon. Treat new mounds as they appear. Do not use a pressure spray since this will disturb colony and encourage migration.

**PREMISE AND FOUNDATION SPRAY**

For the control of pests that may invade the home, such as Ants, Earwigs, Crickets, Sowbugs, Millipedes, and Fleas mix 3 1/2 ounces per gallon of water and apply to cover 35 sq.ft. (3.5 ft x 10 ft.) area of the foundation and adjacent soil. Treat beneath porches and other crawl spaces. Repeat as needed for control. Keep children and pets out of treated area until the spray has dried.
