Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in ornamental gardens or lawns and grounds.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store product in original labeled tightly closed container, in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse this empty container; wrap empty container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

### IMPORTANT APPLICATION STATEMENTS

**ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:** Oil might remove the glaucous (blue) bloom from such evergreens as Colorado Blue Spruce and Koeler Spruce. Use with caution and reduced dosage for summer application on Japanese Red Maple, Amur Maple, and Black Walnut. Use with caution and reduced dosage (1/2 rate) for application on Sugar Maple, Redbud, Chamaecyparis, Cryptomeria, Japanese Holly, Red Cedar and Smoke Tree.

**CITRUS:** Oils applied after October may increase cold damage to your trees; and if applied in August and September may affect solids content, and may retard color.
