The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. On the side panel above the word "Warning" include the "Precautionary Statements" heading.
 - b. Include a Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

WARNING

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye or skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

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CONCURRENCES

SYMBOL							
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If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

- c. The statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" should be placed above the signal word "Warning."
- 2. The revised Confidential Statement of Formula agrees with the label and is acceptable.


Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

WARNING:

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals: Do not spray in eyes. Avoid contamination of food. Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined.

Physical or Chemical Hazards: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent to its labeling.

Air Sanitizer is a highly effective formulation specially designed for use in the timed, intermittent aerosol dispensing unit for the reduction of air-borne bacteria and undesirable odors. Recommended for use in lobbies, reception rooms, locker rooms, rest rooms of hospitals, theaters, shops.

Remove cap of can and place in sequential aerosol dispenser with spray head beneath actuator, nozzle facing front.

Factors such as air currents, temperature, humidity and conformation of treated area govern number of units required for effective control. One unit should normally treat 6,000 cubic feet of closed air space. Dispenser location should be at a height of 8 feet and directed compatibly to air currents in closed area. One can, used on a 24-hour basis, will provide air sanitizing for a 30-day service cycle.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap container and put in trash collection.
