

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Purge Air Sanitizer is a highly effective formulation specially designed for use in the timed, intermittent aerosol dispensing unit for the reduction of airborne bacteria and undesirable odors. Recommended for use in lobbies, reception rooms, locker rooms, rest rooms of hospitals, theaters or shops.

Remove cap from can and place in sequential aerosol dispenser with spray head beneath actuator, nozzle facing front.

Factors such as air currents, temperature, humidity and conformation of treated area govern number of units required for effective control. One unit should normally treat 6,000 cubic feet of closed air space. Dispenser location should be at a height of 8 feet and directed compatibly to air currents in closed area. One can, used on a 24-hour basis, will provide adequate air sanitizing.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where (steel) aerosol can recycling is available.

Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label. **DO NOT PUNCTURE!** If recycling is not available, wrap the container and discard in trash.
