When properly used **SOUTHERN MILL SPRAY** will control grain moths, grain weevils, grain mites, silverfish, roaches, and many other insects that infest food processing establishments. Before spraying thoroughly clean areas to be treated. Applications should be made to exposed stages of insects to insure best results.

SURFACE SPRAY. Treat walls, floors, ceilings, conveyors and other surfaces with Southern Mill Spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 1000 square feet. Cracks and crevices should be treated heavily and thoroughly.

GRAIN TREATMENT **SOUTHERN MILL SPRAY** may be applied directly to the surface of grain without fear of contamination when used as directed. Grain should be leveled and application made after fumigation to prevent moths and other insects from infesting grain surface causing subsequent caking and wetting. Apply 1 gallon of **SOUTHERN MILL SPRAY** per 750 square feet of grain surface. Repeat application as needed.
