The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, R-11, and increasing the amount of another active ingredient is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Submit the flash point of the product with the propellant or change the word "Warning" to "Flammable" preceding the physical cautions.
- 2) The physical and chemical cautions must be placed under the heading "Physical and Chemical Precautions."
- 3) Add the statement "Do not puncture or incinerate" to the Storage and Disposal statements.
- 4) Remove the declaration 10% from the ingredient statement.
- 5) Provide the chemical identity, chemical abstracts number, and percentage in the mixture of each component of Perfume (Pine) WS. Include a Material Safety Data Sheet.

- 6) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year in storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
