

DIRECTIONS FOR USE SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

For Face Flies: Remove mucous secretions and saliva deposits from face of animal. Sparingly apply foam directly or to soft cloth and spread about face and other body regions where flies gather. Repeat daily, or as needed. Apply foam lightly to coat and spread through. Apply to back, belly, ear, or leg regions where the specific attacking insect feeds. Do not treat entire animal. Treat young animals sparingly. Do not apply to back of horses prior to saddling. Repeat daily, or as needed, for protection.

Contents harmful if swallowed. Avoid use which will result in wetting the animals' hide.

PURGE REPELLENT (FOAM)

For temporary protection of horses from attack by horse flies, horn flies, stable flies, deer flies, houseflies, mosquitoes, and gnats. Combines the "Push-Button" convenience of an aerosol with the application ease of a foam. This product is excellent to have in the barn and convenient to take along to fairs, exhibitions, etc., with show animals.

STORAGE & DISPCSAL
