

This product is excellent to have in the barn and convenient to take along to fairs, exhibitions, etc. with show animals.

For Face Flies: Remove mucous secretions and saliva deposits from face of animal. Sparingly apply foam directly or to soft cloth and spread about face and other body regions where flies gather. Repeat daily or as needed. Apply to belly, back, ear, or leg regions where the specific attacking insect feeds. **Do not treat entire animal.** Treat young animals sparingly. Do not apply to back of horses prior to saddling. Repeat daily or as needed for protection. Avoid use which will result in wetting the animal's hide.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: This container may be recycled in the few but growing number of communities where steel aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by using the product according to the label.
