



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

DANGER - PURGE TOTAL RELEASE INSECTICIDE WITH VAPONA is poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin or eyes. Do not breathe vapor. Do not get vapor or liquid on skin or eyes. Do not get on clothing. Wear a full face mask or respirator jointly approved by MSHA, Mine Safety and Health Administration and by NIOSH, National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health for protection against CO₂. Wear rubber gloves. Also wear clean protective clothing with head and skin surfaces covered so that no bare skin is exposed. In case of contact remove contaminated clothing immediately. Wash or shower thoroughly and put on clean clothing, including shoes. Wash hands, arms and face with soap and water before eating or smoking. Evacuate occupants and pets completely from premises before starting treatment. Fish bowls must be covered or removed. House plants must be covered with 8 feet of release paper.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wrap empty container in newspaper and put in trash collection.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Corrosive under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 100°F may cause bursting. Never throw contents into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a potent fumigant. Use this product in a manner consistent with its labeling. Must be used by licensed pest control operators. Use 1.6 oz. can for every 8,000 cubic feet of space. During handling and operation use face mask or respirator jointly approved by MSHA, Mine Safety and Health Administration and NIOSH, National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health for protection against CO₂.

Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using this product in these areas, apply only when the area is empty and unoccupied.

In a room in which people will be treated, place newspaper under fan. Push down tab on top of valve until it is closed. Leave premises immediately. The entire contents will be released automatically. After application, do not re-enter premises for at least 2 hours. Before re-entering, open all doors and windows and ventilate thoroughly. Wash clothes and other fabrics thoroughly. Do not contaminate water supply or other food stuffs. Can should be used in handling empty containers.

RAILROAD CARS

Each car should be treated in a separate area and treated for a minimum of 2 hours before entering. Use 1.6 oz. can for every 100 cubic feet of space. The entire contents will be released automatically. Time and care must be taken in putting out the fire of the material. The vapors are toxic. Treated cars should not be operated for at least 24 hours.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

1. Seal room. 2. Call a physician or Pest Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit is clear. Do not induce vomiting if given anything by mouth to an unconscious person. 3. Wash. 4. Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. 5. Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. 6. Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

WARNING: EYE IRRITATION. Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, irritation from phosphorus, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal cramps. **TREATMENT:** ATROPINE is the specific antidote for the effects of carbamate insecticides.
