The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. As new labels are printed, please note and add a Practical Treatment Statement related to your product. An example of the format is listed below.

Also the formula statement dated January 3, 1991 is acceptable and has been included in our files for this pesticide. Have your supplier of the perfume submit it's complete composition, referencing this pesticide by product name and registration number.

1. Add a Statement of Practical Treatment to include the following format : *(Specific statements may be altered as appropriate)*

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If Inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

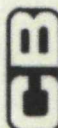
If on Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected skin areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**  
Do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. Do not install directly above or within 12 feet of any food handling or dispensing area.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product contains a highly effective insecticide designed especially for use in automatic dispensers. The dispenser activates the Sizing metered valve every 15 minutes.

Usually the effectiveness of this product will be noticeable within one hour after the Dispenser is activated. If less than 24 hour control is required, the Dispenser should be set to start one hour before control is desired and run one hour after control is no longer needed. Keep in mind that such factors as air flow rate, size of space treated, humidity and temperature will affect insect activity and control. Therefore, one unit per 6,000 cubic feet should be considered as a guide with adjustments made depending on specific conditions at place of usage. As with any method of insect control, best results are achieved when sanitation and other positive insect-prevention practices are followed.

#### KILLS: Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths.

**FOR USE IN:** Food handling and food preparation areas of restaurants and food processing plants and in: stores, farms, dairies, barns, kennels, factories, schools, hotels, motels, offices, ships, planes, supermarkets, food warehouses, bottling plants, hospitals, nursing homes, day care centers, egg and milk handling areas of dairies and chicken houses.

#### STORAGE & DISPOSAL
