INTERNAL: If the material has been swallowed, induce vomiting immediately. This may be done by introducing a finger into the throat or by giving warm salt (1 tablespoon salt to a glass of warm water). NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON.

EXTERNAL: If the material has been spilled on the skin, immediately remove patient from the vicinity of the insecticide, remove all contaminated clothing, and wash skin with soap and running water. If the material gets into the eyes, wash immediately with running water for at least 10 minutes.

IF WARNING SYMPTOMS APPEAR: NEVER ADMINISTER ATROPINE unless warning symptoms appear. (See WARNING SYMPTOMS below.) Keep patient prone and quiet. Start artificial respiration immediately if patient is not breathing. Transport the patient immediately to the nearest hospital.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN — WARNING SYMPTOMS: Symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in chest, blurred vision, non-reactive pin point pupils, salivation, sweeting, nauses, vomiting, diarrhes and abdominal cremps.

TREATMENT: ATROPINE is the specific therapeutic antagonist of choice against parasympathetic nerv us stimulation. If there are signs of parasympathetic stimulation, Atropine Sulfate should be injected at 10-minutes intervals in doses of 1-2 milligrams until complete atropinization has occurred. Morphine is contraindicated. Clear chest by postural drainage. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours.

Repeated exposure to Cholinesterase inhibitors may without warning cause prolonged susceptibility to very small doses of any Cholinesterase inhibitor. Allow no further exposure until time for Cholinesterase regeneration has been allowed as determined by blood tests.

PRECAUTION IN USING: PURGE TOTAL RELEASE INSECTICINE is poisonous. Therefore, precautions must be observed when handling (see ANTIDOTE AND WARNINGS).
