

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

CAUTION

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of vapor. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Wash skin with warm water and soap. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Do not contaminate food or food stuffs. Do not remain in treated areas. Vacate premises for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed and before re-entering.

Volumetric Treatment in Food Areas and/or Food Handling Establishments. Do not apply directly to food in commercial food handling facilities. Cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying for preserving plants, thoroughly wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed. Rinse with hand-washed and rinsed with potable water.

Volumetric Treatment in Homes. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS. Compressed under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.

Do not spray on plastic, painted or varnished surfaces or directly into electronic equipment such as radios, TVs, computers, etc.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Flying Insects. Fly, mosquitoes, crane flies, gnats, wasps, gnats. Calculate cubic feet of space to be treated. Divide total cubic feet by one-half of the sweep length of one part of the room. Apply at rate of one quart per cubic foot of space. Sweep part and destroy to insect life. Repeat as necessary.

Crawling Insects. Cockroaches, ants, beetles, spiders, etc. One square foot of floor area to be treated. Open doors and windows during day. Spray directly on insects or in cracks and crevices where insects hide.

FOR COCKROACHES: For best results, spray directly on cockroaches and thoroughly spray all parts of the item, especially flattening these parts. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, undersinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Also spray around doors and window frames. Repeat as necessary.

CRACK & CREVICE APPLICATION. Food areas and/or food handling establishments, spray in cracks and crevices, using the crack and crevice nozzle provided. A crack and crevice application can be done in food areas and/or food handling establishments while these facilities are in operation by taking extreme care not to contaminate surfaces.

FOR SPIDERS AND SILVERFISH. For control of these insects, frequent and repeated spraying of baseboards, windows, door frames, bookcases and storage areas should be made. For adequate results, spray directly on insects.

FOR CRICKETS. Spray thoroughly and frequently to areas below refrigerators, under stoves, in food storage areas and other areas of the kitchen, basement and other damp areas. For best results spray directly on insects.

FOR FLEAS IN BUILDINGS. Close windows and doors at 30° above 70° and direct fog toward floor, walls, ceiling, corners, etc. If using fogger, make sure that all floors are dry. Do not spray on people. Repeat treatment after 7 days.

FOR ANTS. Spray ant trails, nests, etc. For dry, cracks, crevices, apply 1 to 10 to 60 quarts per 100 sq. feet of treated area. For porous, apply 1 to 60 quarts per 100 sq. feet of treated area. For spaces, spray at 8 sprays at 60° for 3 to 5 seconds per 100 sq. feet of treated area.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE. Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL. Pesticide that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state and local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL. Replace cap and discard empty container in trash sanitary landfill or by other approved state and federal procedures. Do not incinerate or puncture.
