Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Wasps and Yellowjackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary, Residential spraying limited to outdoor application only.
