The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. As new labels are printed incorporate the following recommendations:

- 1. Changes in the Precautionary Statement, "In the home, all food processing surfaces should be covered...", appear contradictory with labeling restricting use as a space spray in the home. Specify during crack and crevice usage to cover utensils, etc.
- 2. The recommended verbiage from the Resmethrin Standard for the active ingredient statement is:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS CAUTION

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate room when treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Wasps and Yellowjackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Residential spraying limited to outdoor application only.

Bees in Buildings: Only use for bees inside building or wall voids where bees are undesirable. Residential spraying limited to external wall application only. (2) Crawling Insects: Cockroaches, waterbugs, earwigs, grain mites, fleas, sowbugs, spiders, centipedes, adult confused flour beetles, sawtoothed grain beetles, shiny spider beetles, carpet beetles.
