CAUTION

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. Cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying, wash all equipment, benches, shelving, etc. where exposed food will be handled, with potable water. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be cleaned during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

Physical or Chemical Hazards: Contains under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Replace cap, wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

FOR HOME USE: Shake well before each use. Remove protective cap. Aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

CONTROL HOUSEHOLD PESTS: HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOS, AND CRANES. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward. Direct spray mist to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist, then leave the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: ROACHES, EARWIGS, GRAIN MITES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, AND CENTIPEDES. Spray liberally into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage area. Spray directly on insects where possible. Reapply as necessary.

OUTDOORS — TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS: Reduce mosquito, gnats (midges), houseflies, biting flies and pyralid and noctuid flying moths by spraying their resting areas. Follow precautions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes, and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow, sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to disperse before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS — TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS: To control aphids, exposed thrips, adult white flies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on smaller rhododendrons, pines, spruce, hemlock spruce, dogwood, palm, mimosa, locust, viburnum, euonymus, maple, maple, locust, forsythia and althea, and numerous webworm larvae on mimosa, spray directly on insects. Hold container 16 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds or spray at the rate of one linear foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Reapply as necessary to obtain control. Spray peonies, iris, dianthus, snapdragons, geraniums, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, daisy, geraniums, marigolds, daphne, lantana, ivy, lobelia, queen sage and broad leaf acacia for control of aphids, exposed thrips, adult white flies, leafhoppers, plant bugs, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles. Spray as directed above.

USE WITH CAUTION ON AZALEAS, JUNIPERS, ROSES, INCLUDING HYBRID TEA ROSES, FLOWERING QUINCE, ASH AND CAMELLIAS. These plants may be subject to leaf or flower burn under certain conditions of use.

PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS: Spray infested African violets, philodendron, geraniums, begonias, caladiums for listed pests. Leave the sprayed area when done indoors, and ventilate area after treatment is completed.

NUISANCE PESTS — OR ON ENTERING BUILDINGS

WASPS: Applications should be made late in the evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Reapply as necessary. Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.

ANTS: Spray trails and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Reapply as necessary.

SPIDERS: Direct short bursts of spray on spiders and reapply as necessary.

EARRINGS: Spray directly on earrings in crevices and other hiding places on outdoor porches, patio floor and doorway entrances.
