Wasps and Hornets:

Direct the spray at those insects when possible. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night.

Ants:

Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants when possible. Repeat as necessary.

Cockroaches	Crickets
Stink Bugs	Earwigs
Batid Bug	Grain Moths
Centipedes	Spiders

Apply as a coarse droplet spray directed into cracks, crevices and other hiding places along baseboards, around the base of machinery and under pallets. Spray thoroughly contacting insects directly whenever possible. Spray badly infested areas daily. In other areas, repeat treatments twice weekly or when reinestation occurs.
